

- Be Respectful

Good to be green

- All children start the day 'good to be green'
- Children remain here whilst they are demonstrating positive learning behaviours
- Dojo points can be added for children ending the day on 'good to be green'

Warning

- Verbal warnings are given at an age appropriate level for breaking school rules

Yellow Card

- Given when children continue to break school rules despite the verbal warning

Red Cards

- Given when negative behaviour continues despite them having a formal warning about behaviour. Parents notified by dojo. Red incident recorded on arbor by the teacher

Internal Exclusion

- HT notified when the learning of others is disrupted or when all of the above appear not to be having an impact on changing behaviour. The length of time spent will be no longer than a full day and will be determined dependent on the severity of the behaviour. During this time they will complete work set by the class teacher. Parents will be informed by dojo. Incident recorded on arbor

Exclusion

- When behaviour endangers the child or others around them including adults including violence consideration will be given to fixed term exclusion or permanent exclusion - See Exclusions policy
